Tests carried out on a Quickly folding table (1 appendix)

1 Introduction

On the instructions of Lammhults Möbel AB, a Quickly folding table has been tested at SP in accordance with Möbelfakta requirement Specification 4.2.2, Tables for contract use, Issue 9810.

2 Test object

The table with a measurement of 1800 x 750 mm and a height of 725 mm consisted of:

Table top: Laminated board, edge list of plastic profile.
Table leg: Steel tubes \varnothing 30 mm chromate. Locking mechanism built in to the board.

The test object was selected by the party commissioning the test, and arrived at SP on 3 July 2001.

3 Test methods and performance of tests

The test methods used are explained in Appendix 1.

Before testing commenced, the test object was not conditioned for 1 week in a climate of $23^{\circ}\text{C} \pm 2^{\circ}\text{C}$ and $50\% \pm 5\%$ relative humidity as specified in the standards. All testing were however, carried out under these climatic conditions.

The test was carried out 3 July 2001 – 10 July 2001.

4 Result


The result is reported in Appendix 1.


After carrying out the tests, the tested piece of furniture did not demonstrate any ruptures, fractures or other damages that can affect the safe use of the article as per ENV 12521.

After carrying out the tests, the tested piece of furniture did not demonstrate any damages or deformations that can affect the durability or appearance.

The test result only applies to the tested sample.
