The refined proportions of Chipperfield's modular hm93 design with its distinctive inset backrest positions, combines a dynamic and well-defined aesthetic with a high level of comfort. The range comprises one, two and three seat units, together with left- and right-handed chaise-longues and daybeds to allow the configuration of corner arrangements. The collection includes a generously proportioned double-fronted seating unit with the option of either straight or staggered backs, and a low coffee table.

Frames are of FSC-accredited timber and panel construction with upholstery of graded cmhr foams. Legs are of fine-brushed stainless steel; table tops are of polished Carrara marble or white laminate.



Founded in 1984, David Chipperfield Architects serves an impressive client list through offices in London, Berlin, Milan and Shanghai. Since graduating from London's Architectural Association, Chipperfield has won numerous international awards including the RIBA Stirling Prize 2007.
